Kentucky, January 14, 1803
 Indenture between James Young and Joseph Allen whereby Young sells a parcel of land to Allen for the sum of 233-pound current money of Kentucky.

Clark County, Kentucky, October 25, 1813
 Indenture between John and Judith King and Joseph Allen whereby the Kings sell a parcel of land to Allen for \$270.

Harrison County, Kentucky. September 20, 1829
 Indenture between Matthew and Lucy Givens and Joseph Allen whereby the Givens sell a parcel of land to Allen for \$2,289

Montgomery County, Kentucky, December 28, 1837
 Indenture between Joseph Allen, Sr. and Joseph Allen, Jr. whereby Allen, Sr. sells Allen, Jr. fifty acres of land at \$30 an acre.

Montgomery County, Kentucky, December 28, 1837
 Indenture between John and Elizabeth Groves and Joseph Allen, Sr. whereby the Groves sell Allen, Sr. a parcel of land for \$5,000.

Unidentified location, December 31, 1844
 Note signed by the heirs of Joseph and Frances Allen stating they will pay for any damage or loss to the administrators of the Allen estate, due to the sale of Martin and Caty, the dower Negroes. Also will pay for damage which may accrue from the heirs of Wright Allen. Signed by William W. Allen, James R. Boardman, Margaret Landen, and David Allen.

Unidentified location, March 1, 1845

Receipt for the payment of \$59.44 from Joseph Allen to James Allen.

Putnam County, Indiana, March 24, 1866

Warrantee Deed (indenture) by which James and Permelia O'Neal sell a portion of land to D. E. Williamson.

Putnam County, Indiana, April 27, 1875

Indenture between William A. and Mary Jane Brown whereby the Browns sell one hundred acres to Joseph Allen.
