#### **Envelopes**

This series contains envelopes addressed to Mrs. Tabitha and Henry [William Henry] Dorris at Swan Creek, Warren County and Young America, Warren County. Prior to their archival arrangement, the letters in this collection were placed in plastic folders within two binders. As part of this arrangement process, the letters were separated from the envelopes in which they were sent. The letters that the envelopes were previously housed with in the binders are indicated on the Permalife folders housing the envelopes.

#### **Research Notes**

Research notes on the William Henderson Dorris Papers created by unknown individual, undated.

#### Binder

This binder served as the original housing for correspondence dated from April 8, 1864, to August 17, 1903. Letters were enclosed in plastic folders within the binder. Correspondence dating from August 1, 1858, to February 15, 1864, was housed in a white binder with red designs and similarly enclosed in plastic folders. The white and red binder was discarded, as it contained traces of mold. The blue binder included within this collection bears numerous drawings likely created by a child.
