I. Correspondence

The first series of papers in this group consists of the family's correspondence. This includes letters between Sarah Langworthy Taylor and Joseph I. Taylor, Joseph I. The correspondence in each of the six groups is arranged in chronological order. The correspondence between Sarah and Joseph I. Taylor falls into two groups, the letters written during their courtship, 1849-1850, and those written by Taylor during his tour of Europe and the Near East, 1867. The latter letters contain lengthy descriptions of points of interest.
