(The University of Illinois General Advisory Committee - name changed to Citizens Committee in January, 1947 - was established by the Board of Trustees in 1941 to advise the President on matters relating to the welfare of the institution, its development and services to the State, and on questions of general public policy. Essentially, the

General Advisory Committee is a committee of citizens, not alumni of the University, who are appointed by the Board of Trustees to serve for four years. Included in the membership in an ex-officio capacity are the present and former members of the Board of Trustees, the officers and directors of the Alumni Association and the Dads' Association, and the members of the advisory committees of the colleges and schools of the University.)
