Series 2: Superintendent of Schools, 1917-1934. This collection includes work materials, writings, and published articles from Skye's time as superintendent of Horton High School and Rockland Township Schools. This includes recommendation letters written about him, his high school and college transcripts, and application to be superintendent of Houghton MI. Included are reports Skye wrote on the recommended courses of study for high schools, and on the consolidation of rural schools. Also included is Skye's "By-Laws Board of Education District 148", written while on the school board for the district including Riverdale, Dolton, and Ivanhoe.
