- The Long-Bell Lumber Company of Kansas City Missouri was incorporated in 1884. According to the F inanc Guide Service: 1995 directory of Obsolete Securities it was reorganized December 17, 1935 and merge with Long Bell Lumber Corporation) into International Paper Co. effective November 5, 1956. The F Lumber Company of Kansas City Missouri began business in 1894. According to the 1995 directory of Securities, the Company was reorganized as Pickering Lumber Corporation in 1937. Its name was char PLC Liquidating Corporation on July 26, 1965. Liquidation was completed June 17, 1966.
- The financial reorganizations of the Long-Bell Lumber Company and of the Pickering Lumber Company were by Clarence T. MacNeille and the staff of Halsey Stuart and Company of Chicago, an underwriter, distrib dealer in municipal and corporate bonds.
- The Long-Bell and Pickering Reorganization Records were accessioned into the University Archives in June 196 of the Business Archives previously managed by Icko Iben, Newspaper L ibrarian and Business A Presumably, they were acquired by the University of Illinois as part of the business records collection initiated by Dean Charles M. Thompson in the late 1930s.
