Series 1: Biographical, 1903-2012

This series contains biographical sketches listing Lewis's professional activities, honors, and membership in professional societies. Lewis's compilation of achievements includes correspondence, programs, and articles about Lewis's conferences. The series also contains a brochure advertising his co-authored textbook: *Construction: Principles, Materials, and Methods*; personal correspondence; and certificates of professional recognition, such as his American Institute of Architects (AIA) College of Fellows certificate. The series also contains Lewis's U of I sabbatical applications. During these sabbaticals he wrote the *Construction* book of the US Savings and Loan League's *Construction Lending Guide*, gave talks sponsored by the US Savings and Loan League, and worked as a research architect for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Construction Engineering Research Laboratory. Also included are Lewis's U of I faculty appointment pay rates; his U.S. Army honorable discharge, Central Illinois Honor Flight correspondence, and his army photograph.
