Transit & Bus Shelter Ad Bulletins and Transit Ads, 1944-

This record series consists of three different types of media:

- 1) Ad Bulletins, which contain campaign information and instructions for ordering materials. Before 1997, most of these are on regular (8 1/2" x 11") paper and include miniature black and white reproductions of advertisements. After 1997, most of these are in the form of glossy postcards with miniature color reproductions of advertisements.
- 2) glossy reproductions in miniature (generally half-size or quarter-size) of Transit Ads and car cards, with no accompanying documentation.
- 3) actual Transit Ads, which are of varying sizes.

The Transit and Bus Shelter Ad Bulletins (1989-) and the glossies (1949-1957) are described in the first section of this SFA and housed in a single .3 cubic foot box.

The Transit Ads are described in the second, and larger, section of this SFA, and they take up approximately eight cubic feet, divided into oversized boxes and map drawers. The notation for this section of the finding aid is different than most. At the left, in bold letters, is the name of the campaign. Underneath are the slogans printed on a specific ad. The next column over, size, usually only has one number - the width. Where this is the case, it is assumed that the height is 11 inches. In cases where the height is a different number, both dimensions are listed. The next column over lists the date the ad was produced. In cases where there is no date, "nd" is listed. The final column states the location of the particular ad. Ads that are 21 inches or less in width can be found in Boxes 2-5, which are located with the oversized boxes. Ads that are 28 inches in width or larger can be found in map drawers.
