Series 1: Lifestory: Comprehensive scrapbooks documenting June Skye's life through photographs, journaling, and memorabilia. (1929-1950)

This series consists of Szirtony's CV, a list of her publications, information about Karoly Szirotny, the book: George Eliot's Feminism: A Right to Rebellion, four issues of the magazine "Children's Activities for Home and School" from 1938-1939, in which are stories submitted by June Skye as a child, and ten detailed scrapbooks on the early life of June Marjorie (Skye) Szirotny, created by her mother: Esther Pearce Skye. The scrapbooks cover the years from June Skye's birth in Riverdale, Illinois, in 1929 to young adulthood at the University of Michigan. They include extensive notes on Skye's childhood, collected memorabilia, and hundreds of photographs by Esther Pearce Skye. The scrapbooks show life in the Midwestern United States in the 30s and 40s from the perspective of a small town mother documenting the lives of her children.

Content note: This scrapbook contains information on June's first seven years of life. Included are photographs and memorabilia such as her birth certificate, medical examinations, and cards. The scrapbooks records June's development, such as her height and weight through the seven years, when she first made noises and talked, when she first recognized her mother and father, and more. June's mother also kept a record of details such as each of her first seven birthday parties—including the gifts she received and the guests that came--how they celebrated each holiday, and June's experiences starting school.

Content note: This scrapbook contains information on June's early life. This includes detailed descriptions of June's physical development, letter's June received, photographs, and other memorabilia from June's life.
