Many innovations were tried.

- C. Physical
- D. Physical Science (DGS course including physics, astronomy, chemistry and geology. I was a member of the group which organized the DGS program of courses in the late 1930s and the Physical Science course.
- E. Field mapping course taught in Easter vacation week in the spring, successively near Elizabethtown, Rushville, LaSalle, Golconda, Vienna, and Makanda, Illinois, and Marion, Kentucky.
- F. Field course for students with one or more semesters of geology, for may tears having involved a trip southeastward from Urbana, to the Great Smoky Mountains, crossing several structural and geomorphic belts, with written student reports on particular topic turned in.
- G. Western summer field camp. I had charge of this program in its first two years, 1950-51 near Durango, Colorado. An 8-Weeks course filling the entire summer session.
- H. Geologic history of vertebrates. An elementary and popular course in development and history of vertebrates taught for several years in the late 1920s. Required one or two semesters of geology.
- I. Topographic and geologic maps. A course for senior majors taught in the 1940s.
- J. Geology of Illinois. A course for Juniors or seniors taught in the later 1940s.
- K. Sedimentation. A graduate course taught most years between 1929 and 1967.
- L. Sedimentary petrology. A graduate course dealing largely with methods of analyzing sediments taught in the early 1940s, and later taken over by Hough and still later Richards.
- M. Advanced dynamic geology. A graduate course dealing with geologic processes of all sorts. Taught from late 1930s to 1960s.

- N. An Advanced historical geology. A graduate level summary of the knowledge of the history of the earth, and of life on it.
- O. Geology of the Upper Mississippi Valley. A graduate course involving six week-end field trips during the fall semester, and reports on them.
- P. Pennsylvanian Geology. A graduate seminar type course taught from 1950 to 1967. Involved a field trip generally about four days in length.
- Q. Photogeology. Geological interpretations from aerial photographs. A graduate course taught from about 1960 to 1969. Much laboratory work with individual interpretive studies of various types of terrain.

MEMORIAL TO HAROLD ROLLIN WANLESS (1898-1970)

Harold Rollin Wanless joined the staff of the Department of Geology of the University of Illinois in 1923. He was born in Chicago, December 5, 1898, the son of William and Rhoda Tanner Wanless. After graduation from Robert Waller High School in Chicago, he entered Princeton University on a scholarship and received the B. S. degree in 1920 and was appointed to a fellowship in the Princeton Graduate School. He received the M.A. degree in 1921 and the Ph.D. in 1923. He came to the University of Illinois in 1923 as an instructor and rose through the ranks of associate, assistant professor, and associate professor to a professorship in 1946. He was Chairman of the Department during the academic year 1946-47. Although he became professor emeritus in 1967, his research and publications not only continued but even increased until shortly before his death on June 3, 1970, in his 72nd year.

He married the former Grace Rogers in 1926 and she together with a son, Harold Rogers Wanless, now completing his work for the Ph.D. in geology at The John Hopkins University, and a grandson, David survive.

Professor Wanless' earlier work on the Tertiary rocks of the Badlands region in South Dakota resulted in two monographic reports. However soon after coming to Illinois, he began studies of the Paleozoic rocks of Illinois, particularly the late Paleozoic (Carboniferous - Pennsylvanian) rocks which contain the large coal deposits. He extended his work on these rocks from Illinois to adjoining states and then to all parts of North America and eventually to the study of these coal-bearing rocks in Europe and Australia. His interest was primarily their origin, petrographic character, and the repetitive cycles they exhibited. His theories of cyclic sedimentation and of the environment in which the rocks were deposited gained world-wide acceptance and acclaim. He was invited to national and international conferences to discuss his findings. His publications include more than 100 journal articles and seven books, several of which are now basic reference works.

In addition to his wide-ranging work of the coal-bearing rocks, he made significant contributions in the fields of glacial geology, geomorphology, sedimentary petrology and paleontology. He was one of the earliest geologists to use air photographs and soon became a leader in the field of photo-geology. He was widely sought as a consultant by mineral industry companies, but (which some thought a bit quixotic) accepted very few such invitation because it would take him away from his work with students and joint research with them.

Professor Wanless was President of the Illinois academy of Science in 1938, Senior Research Fellow in Australia in 1958-59, President of U.I. Chapter of Sigma Xi in 1964-65, Distinguished Lecturer of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists in 1956, and an invited lecturer at the British Association for the Advancement of Science in 1967 and at the Sixth International Carboniferous Congress in England in 1967. He was a member of several international geological congresses, in which he took active part in sessions and field excursions.
