Classification Note:

Below is a list of the categories of the materials and a brief description of the types of materials found in each.

Book Reviews - Contain book reviews by and about Winton U. Solberg.

Correspondence and Subject File - Correspondence with publications, colleagues, students, and visiting scholars relating to Solberg's role as a professor.

Course Materials – Rosters, exams, assignments, syllabi, lecture outlines, student papers, and other materials related to the teaching of a course.

Lecture Materials – Notes, drafts, scripts, and correspondence relating to lectures given by Solberg outside of the classroom.

Lectures, Dictionaries, Publications - Notes, correspondence, drafts, and research materials relating to lectures given, the process of publication of articles and books, and the publishing of dictionary and encyclopedia entries.

Personal and Biographical - Documents relating to Solberg's personal life and scholarly career.

Research Materials – A combination of notes and other materials (e.g., articles, book chapters, bibliographies, correspondence, photos, photocopies, etc.) concerning a given research topic or project.
