The series covers Professor Fields' activities during his time at University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign. The series contains correspondence, CIA and FBI files compiled on Fields, reports, memorandums, articles and speeches, unpublished manuscript, announcements, fliers, press releases, and news-clippings. Correspondents include faculty and administration at the University and other institutions, as well as national policy actors. Included are his talks and statements about political matters on the Iraq war and the University's involvement in police force training, appointments, and visits to the campus. Also included is his support of student activism and minorities' representation on campus, including his association with Citizens for Racial Justice. It is arranged alphabetically by folder title.
