Between 1925 and 1939, the correspondence is principally between S. Charles Kendeigh and S. Prentiss Baldwin. Following Baldwin's death late in 1939, much of the correspondence concerns memorials to Baldwin and Kendeigh's efforts to carry on his work. There is also correspondence pertaining to Kendeigh's summer research projects both at Gates Mills, Ohio and the Edmund Huyck Preserve in Rensselaerville, New York, 1942-46. There are no family letters.

There are 43 bound volumes in this set -- the first three contain Dr. Baldwin's ornithological work starting in 1915. Kendeigh joined Baldwin in 1925 and all subsequent volumes pertain to Kendeigh's summer research projects from 1925 to 1940 at Gates Mills, Ohio, principally on House Wrens. All the titles are exact -- as given on the spine of the volume. Worley, Boulton, Bowen, Franks, and Stevenson were research assistants.
