It then evolved into the National Two-Year College Council (NTCC). In 1994-95, TYCA was established as a professional group situated within the College Section of the NCTE. There are seven regional associations of TYCA with conferences in the Midwest, Northeast, Pacific Coast, Pacific Northwest, Southeast, Southwest, and West.
