1950 Asia/Pacific Trip

NOTE: the majority of images for this trip were received in transfile boxes after the initial processing was completed in 1988-89, and remained unprocessed until 2021. At that time they consisted of batches of kraft-paper, photo processor envelopes containing negatives and batches of prints and contact sheets. Some of the batches were still held together by aging rubber bands, but many of the rubber bands had already broken. The prints were largely loose and generally not identified as to country. The kraft-paper negative envelopes generally marked in Strohm's hand with a red-orange grease pencil (also found in the transfile box) showing the name of country and the year. There was considerable overlap of subject matter in the images for Malaya and Indonesia. Sorting of those prints by country was largely done based on comparing negatives for which Strohm had labeled the envelope with the country name, or sorting was based on the limited number of contact sheets he had marked by country. However, since the contact sheets are from sheet film negatives rather than roll film, there are instances where it seems that negatives created at disparate places and times could end up on the same contact sheets. When the meaning of one of Strohm's labels was unclear, possibly inaccurate, or reflected an obsolete geographic indicator, quote marks are used to indicate what is now listed on the folder tab or in the finding aid based on his designations whenever possible.
