- "THE UNIVERSITY SERVES THE WHOLE STATE"--focuses on off-campus services through extension, adult education, short courses, and conferences. 26 and half minutes running time. Immediately available.
- "STUDENT LIFE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS"--answers questions of prospective students and their parents about enrollments, programs of study, and other aspects of interest to young people who plan to enter the University. 27 and half minutes running time. Heavily booked through June 1, but available thereafter.
- "THE DEDICATED"--gives a resume of teaching and research programs being carried on in the Chicago Professional Colleges; also deals with aspects of service units CPC. 24 and half minutes running time. Immediately available.

You will find these films interesting and informative for many types of groups--University students, high school students, parents' groups, service clubs, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, church groups, and civic organizations. Only cost involved in showing is return postage if mailing is involved.
